

## The Book That Killed Charlie Hebdo

You may be wondering who killed Charlie Hebdo. The government of France believes that they killed the killer of Charlie Hebdo. The bad news is that the killer is still free and secure. In fact, the people honour the killer, countries welcome this killer, and they try to protect this killer.

The killer is not a person or an organization – it is a book that 1.5 billion people believe is divine, and most of the rest of the world seem to accept this as fact. This book commands people to kill anyone who does not believe in Islam and those who say anything bad about the prophet of Islam. The book is called the Quran and Muslims believe that this book is the word of god. In the Quran 5:33 it says:

The punishment of those who wage war against Allah and His Messenger, and strive with might and main for mischief through the land is: execution, or crucifixion, or the cutting off of hands and feet from opposite sides, or exile from the land: that is their disgrace in this world, and a heavy punishment is theirs in the Hereafter.

This verse is just one of many in the Quran that command Muslims to kill non-Muslims.

Based on this and other verses from the Quran, Muslims killed the 12 people in France who worked for Charlie Hebdo.

Based on the Quran, Muslims plotted the destruction carried out on 9/11 in the United States.

Based on the Quran, Muslims cause great unrest and terror in Middle East in places such as Iraq, Syria, Libya and other countries.

The Bible tells us to love our neighbours. Muslims are our neighbours, so we love them in the name of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. He tells us to love our enemies and to pray for those who persecute us.

In contrast, they kill us because the Quran tells them to do so.
